The main ingredient of our recipe is to continue inviting all sectors of the economy to participate in eradicating stunting in children under 5 years of age by 2030.



Breastmilk is an indispensable and perfect mix, composed of water, fats, minerals, proteins, calcium, phosphor, iron, zinc, vitamins A, E, D, K, water-soluble vitamins and carbohydrates, as well as immune factors.

Our objective is to achieve that all families attended to by Fundación Éxito breastfeed exclusively during the first six months, as recommended by the World Health Organization. In line with this goal, 69%* of the babies attended to in 2018 were exclusively breastfed during this period. Breastfeeding, together with complementary feeding should continue up to two years of age.




SPECIAL SIDE DISHES

Supporting Human Milk Banks

Development of a Breastmilk donation campaign and support of Human Milk Banks, in partnership with the Ministry of Health and Social Protection of Colombia and the Santa Fe de Bogotá Foundation. Fundación Éxito invested over **USD 338,488**, benefitting over **9,300** children in the 15 Human Milk Banks across the country.

Lactatón Gen Cero, Fourth Edition (Big Latch On) Within the frame of the Child Nutrition Month, over 20,000 people gathered to encourage 12,052 exemplary mothers to breastfeed in public spaces in 30 municipalities over 15 Colombian departments. Doing so simultaneously at a national level, they delivered the fundamental message that breastfeeding is the most nourishing act of love.



CHILD NUTRITION AWARD



Award honoring public and private organizations that implement projects which improve health and maternal and infant nutrition. Six programs and a company were awarded, as well as six Grupo Éxito stores, the latter for their outstanding management of recycling and Goticas sales.

FOOD SUPPLEMENTATION



In 2018, we provided food assistance for 33,104 children. Among them, 26,158 were under 2 years of age (1,000 days) and 6,946 were 2 to 5 years old. Thanks to Fundación Éxito's nutrition programs, these children and their families, through 116 partner institutions, received well-balanced grocery packages filled with proteins, vegetables, fruits, cereals, legumes, tubers, dairy products, oils, fats and flours every month during the course of the year.



WHAT IS THE RECIPE FOR FEEDING COLOMBIAN CHILDREN?

GOTICA-BASED PREPARATION

RECYCLING-BASED PREPARATION

- Prior to financing projects, institutions specialized in child comprehensive care, focused on attending children in their first thousand days with stunting or at risk of suffering this condition, are put on the table.
- 2. Day by day, contributions through *Goticas*, donations made by clients of Grupo Éxito's stores, are added up to the mixture of resources granted by the company, its employees, its allies and Fundación Éxito. This mix is applied directly to the projects.
- 3. Month by month, the children and their families visit the retail stores to select their groceries, following **nutritional recommendations** which ensure that they gather ingredients from all food groups. In cases where it is not possible for the beneficiaries to go to the stores, they receive preprepared food packages.



- Add cardboard, plastics and other recyclable materials donated entirely by Grupo Éxito to Fundación Éxito.
- These materials are loaded into trucks, filled with tons of recovered matter that will not land in landfills. These materials are then commercialized and all money resulting...
- Blends with other resources managed by Fundación Éxito and are ready to be converted into food, just as the Goticas!

- Progress in the nutritional state of children
 - Assessment of the achievements to renew joint funding

We delivered over 193,000 certificates of donations to clients contributing to achieving Gen Cero through Goticas* and Vueltos**.

FOOD FOR THE SOUL

Our complementary offer programs include financial support for the institution's education agents and endowment, benefitting 23,134 children. Additionally, Fundación Éxito supports special initiatives, such as:

Semillas de Apego (lit. Attachment Seeds)
In the Tumaco region, where communities suffer from the Colombian armed conflict, we are conducting a project focused on caregiving and essential emotional ties between a child and their mother or caregiver, in partnership with FEMSA, University of Los Andes and Genesis Foundation.

Musical Awakening Programs

A unique ingredient that contributes to the development of expression skills and thinking abilities through music, feeding the minds of 1,126 children, in partnership with the Antioquia Symphony Orchestra.

Reading Programs

Reading nurtures social skills, language development and strengthens emotional ties between caregivers and children.

HOUSE SPECIALS

Model "From Bogotá to Colombia"

We are progressing in the development of the first national guide for Comprehensive Care against Chronic Malnutrition. In partnership with Santa Fe de Bogotá Foundation, the District Secretary of Health, the Department of Social Integration and the Colombian Family Welfare Institute (ICBF), the program benefitted 1,126 families through training on guidelines on health, childcare and parenting, and a monthly food delivery. Fundación Éxito invested over USD 584,660.

Document disclosing the current status of Colombia and its municipalities regarding the social determinants of stunting.

Model for Public Policy Advocacy

With the help of the University of EAFIT and Save the Children, we designed a specific model to foster agreements and actions regarding the eradication of stunting at national and regional administration. The Strategy for Territorial Impact allowed capacity-building in 8 municipalities for that purpose.

Participation in Observatories for Government Management

We mobilize government leaders to monitor health and nutrition indicators. Participating in *Medellín Cómo Vamos* (assessment of the city's administration) allowed us to enable the improvement of coverage and the number of operation days of

the *Buen Comienzo* program (lit. Healthy Start, in charge of early childhood care). It also permitted the lengthening of exclusive breastfeeding in the city to over 4 months, when the regional average in Antioquia was of 0.6 month according to the 2010 National Survey of the Nutritional Situation of Colombia (ENSIN 2010). In *Así Vamos en Salud* (Observatory for Health with national coverage) we promoted political advocacy in rural regions.

We are Gen Cero Volunteering

194 employees of Grupo Éxito in Colombia volunteered, learning about and supporting our actions with the beneficiary populations. In total, 1,003 hours were donated for child nutrition, accounting for an estimated USD 3,662.

The Pure Flavor of Vaupés (Amazonas)

We reached Vaupes in the Amazon region, which has one of the highest prevalence of stunting in Colombia, through the ONG Sinergias, to attend the predominantly indigenous child population of the department. In 2018, we strengthened 5 care centers in Mitú for a better monitoring of pregnant mothers and children under 5 years of age. We also improved the programs at 38 welfare community homes (daycare centers jointly administered by the State and the communities), based on an effective comprehensive care model for the children of Vaupés. In this process, we outlined the nutritional value of their local ingredients and showed them how to make a better use of them.

RECOMMENDATION



We convey our drive to serve Colombia and its children by encouraging others to commit and share actions. As organization, we give the best we can offer: a commitment from the heart, reinforced by our capacity to mobilize and leverage resources.

To safeguard and promote the welfare of children, we encourage solidarity from our employees, businesses, brands, suppliers and clients, since only together we will be able to transform the reality for early childhood in Colombia.

By doing so we will succeed in ensuring that no child in Colombia suffers from stunting, an affliction that hinders them from nurturing their most basic dreams as human beings: live without hunger, grow with love, smile without fear, learn without limits and thrive.



According to Fundación Éxito's analysis of the results of its intervention, there is a correlation between the GINI coefficient (measure of income inequality) and the prevalence of stunting in the different regions of the country: Where the inequalities are lower, recovery rates are better.

 Norte de Santander: ninth least unequal department in Colombia. There, 3 of 4 children attended to by Fundación Éxito recovered from stunting.

 Valle: One of the least unequal departments. 2 of 3 children suffering from stunting improved their condition.

 Bogotá: GINI coefficient of 0,498 (sixth highest), only 21% of children suffering from stunting recovered.

Dinner is ready!

This common expression in our country brings back memories of times of enjoyment, inclusion, celebration, festivities. For thousands of children, it is a rare call in their homes, an exception,

almost a miracle considering the fact that there is hardly food on the table every day, as should be their right and that of everyone. Among the 63,587 children participating in our programs in 2018, 33,104 heard this call in their homes every night, and went to bed after eating well throughout the day, together with their families, every day of the year. It is so heartwarming to be able to provide nutritive food to our beneficiaries, knowing what will happen to the children

eating well: their probability of recovering from stunting and of their brains developing normally increases, so that in the future they can learn, interact with others, strive and enjoy life. Therefore, we can say that, thanks to our actions every year, thousands of children grow with healthy brains and bodies, and joyful hearts.
